

IPC's May Messy Church: Creation

In this document you will find all the information you need to do this month's Messy Church activities at home!

Station 1: Leaf Etchings

Materials: Leaves, plain paper, crayons/colored pencils

Instructions

Gather an assortment of leaves from your yard or neighborhood.

Place a piece of plain paper over them.

Color over on the paper on top of where the leaf is. Watch it appear!

Prayer

Dear God, Nature reveals your glory. Help me to see it. Amen.

Station 2: Show & Tell

Materials: Anything that you love that reminds you of God's creation (For example: a pet, a family member, a picture of a place you love to go, a plant, etc.)

Instructions

Once you've identified something, talk about it with the people in your family.

Why do you love it? How does it help you connect with God?

Prayer

Dear God, Thank you for give us so many wonderful things to remind us of your love. Amen.

Station 3: A New Creation

Materials: Anything you have sitting around that you could use to be creative! (For example: playdoh, craft supplies, stuff in your recycling bin, glue, scissors, markers)

Instructions

Using whatever materials you've rounded up, create something new! Does it look like a plant, animal, fish, bird, or something else altogether? What name would you give your new species? Talk about why you made it the way you did.

Reflection

Every creature (and everything!) that God has made is important, solely because God made it – including you! How can we take good care of God's creation? How can we take better care of ourselves?

Station 4: Water Xylophone

Materials: Pitcher of water; glass jars/bowls; metal spoon

Instructions

Carefully pour some water into each container

Gently tap on the side of each container with the spoon

Notice how it sounds

Try adding more water into some jars and pour some out of other jars

Notice how that changes the sounds

See if you can make a song using your water jars!

Reflection

All of creation sings God's praise! This week, pay extra attention to the sounds that you hear. How might they be praising God?
